

FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

Your puppy is eating **Royal Canin Small Puppy** dry puppy food. I have included a daily feeding chart from the Royal Canin website. Please feed the puppy based on an adult weight of 11 pounds for females and 13 pounds for males.

It's not unusual for your puppy not to eat the first day or until the next day when they first go home. They will eat when they are hungry! Your puppy should eat three times per day until four months of age and then twice thereafter. Keep your puppy on puppy formula until they are ten months old or your veterinarian recommends otherwise.

Please keep your puppy on this formula for at least two weeks after arriving home. Changing their food can create digestive issues and they are still acclimating to a new environment which can be stressful.

If you want to change foods start by adding a small amount of new food to the old and increase the new food every day for 6-7 days until you're feeding the new food only. Sudden changes create digestive issues so be sure to transition their food slowly.
